Gregory has represented Australia as an Ambassador and High Commissioner in West Africa, and as a diplomat in China, Japan and the United Nations. He was Australia's first-appointed Threatened Species Commissioner. He wrote and implemented Australia's first Threatened Species Strategy and first Threatened Species Prospectus.

As a not-for-profit CEO, Gregory led, grew and reformed a national Indigenous charity. He is an experienced Indigenous champion and career mentor for First Nations peoples.

Gregory speaks French and Mandarin. He has an Honours Degree in Econometrics and a Masters in Foreign Affairs and Trade.

Gregory is an Associate Adjunct Professor at the University of Canberra and owns and manages a 50 hectare conservation property in NSW.
